#### YOUR STORY

Read Paul's story about how he met Jesus in **1 Timothy 1:12-17.**Just as Paul told others his story, so you can tell your friends, family and acquaintances your own story about how Jesus saved you from your sin.

Let's look at how Paul does it in the **book of Acts chapter 22**. He offered to explain his story to them (vs. 1); he used words that people understand (vs. 2) and He identified with the behaviour, attitudes and thoughts of his hearers (vs.3-5), he then told them how he was changed when he heard the word of truth and what happened to bring him to repent and accept Jesus as his Lord (vs.6-16). When you tell your story, do not brag about how bad you were. Do not give the impression that when you become a Christian, all problems end and do not be critical about other individuals, groups or churches. Remember you are just one beggar telling another beggar where to find bread. Take some time to write down the story of how you found new life in Jesus.



Instead, we get mothers bringing up their children alone; children suffering from lack of food, clothing and education; youths suffering from lack of love and security: people suffering from sexually transmitted diseases and AIDS. But this is

They don't realise that they are being deceived. It is time to examine the truth. God designed sex therefore we must follow the designer's instructions. Follow His ways and you will save yourself and others a lot of heartache.

#### SEX IS FOR BLESSING (TO BRING GOOD TO ALL)

To be fruitful and multiply, we must have sex. But take note of the condition that God placed on sex: He BLESSED them. God keeps us connected in families and he wants sex to bring blessing (maximum good) to all of us. Sex brings blessing when we have happy homes. A happy home is a place where a faithful husband and a faithful wife are loving and kind to each other. They are a mother and a father who take responsibility for their children to provide for and care for them. They bless each other and bless their children.

#### **HOW DO WE GET THIS BLESSING?**

Study **Genesis 2:7-22** very carefully. God only ever made one adult male and then one adult female. God brought her to the man to see what the man would call her, to see if she would be identified by the man as his suitable helper. God did not just give her to the man; He waited to see what the man would call her.

#### **KEEP YOUR HOUSE CLEAN**

1 John 1:9 says, "If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness." As you live together with Jesus, He will show you some places in your house which need to be cleaned and some rooms which you have locked so that He cannot go in. By reading His Word and obeying His commands, your house will stay clean and you will have constant fellowship with Jesus.

Let Jesus shine the light of His Word into your heart. Obey Him, so that your house will stay clean! Before a man and woman become one flesh, two things must be in place. In God's order, sex comes after he has become independent of his parents and has been joined to his wife.

In Greek, the original language of the New Testament, there are three words used for three kinds of love: EROS, PHILEOS and AGAPE. Love between a man and a woman needs all three kinds of love. All of them are found in God's instruction to us about marriage in **Genesis 2:24.** 

#### Leaving is the wedding

At a wedding ceremony, the man gives his name to the woman and the woman takes his name. This is what makes people married. This is like "AGAPE" love which is unconditional love. To love like this means to be faithful to the one whose name you share, no matter what. A wedding is a one-time commitment. It is leaving your original family to cleave to another person. God wants marriage to be a lifetime of keeping that commitment.



#### Cleaving is love in action

Cleaving to each other is practicing the commitment that you made on the wedding day. This is like PHILEOS love, the kind of love we show to all our fellow human beings because we respect them. It is treating the other person the way you would like to be treated. **Marriage is so much more than just the wedding.** 

God wants a couple to show their respect for each other by putting the characteristics of love, found in **1 Corinthians 13:4 – 6**, into practice.

Love is patient, love is kind, love is not jealous, love does not boast. Love is not rude, not proud, not self-seeking, not easily angered. Love does not keep a record of wrongs. Love does not delight in evil, but love rejoices with the truth. Love always protects, always trusts, always hopes and never gives up.

One flesh is sex. "EROS" is the desire and attraction which draws two people of the opposite sex together. Erotic/sexual love is a good and necessary part of marriage. God designed a man and a woman so that they would enjoy the pleasure of becoming one flesh. Sex is only one third of the love between a man and a woman. Eros without respect and without trust is NOT true love.

#### **GOOD NEWS**

"Do not awaken love until the time is right." **Song of Songs 3:5b.** The time to start a relationship with a member of the opposite sex is:

- You have reached manhood and womanhood when
- Ready to be independent of your parents
- Are committed to each other for life

You may become sexually intimate (one flesh) only when you have married that person in a public and legal ceremony. This is God's standard and this will bring blessing.

Young people are under too much pressure to have boyfriend/girlfriend relationships and have sex with each other as this is not God's way. This is good news. You are not obliged to have a boyfriend or girlfriend. You do not need to have sex.

#### **Adultery**

Is sex with someone who is married to someone else.

#### **Sexual Immorality**

Refers to the all sexual activity outside of the one-man-with-one-woman-marriage relationship. It includes: sex before marriage, adultery, homosexual acts, prostitution, incest (sex between family members), rape, lust, bestiality (sex between a human and an animal) and obscene speech.

Read about it in **Leviticus 18 and 20**. God is not against friendships between boys and girls, but He is against **ANY** sexual intimacy between a boy and girl or between a man and woman who are not married to each other.

#### Pure sex

**Is having sex only with your marriage partner.** Pure sex is to keep your heart and soul and mind for only that one person. God absolutely approves of pure sex in marriage. You are commanded to keep sex pure. If you do not, God will judge you.

And then one day Jesus said, "Penda, you need to open this door so that I can come in." "No!" cried Penda. "I'm ashamed of my friends. They are bad, but I'm afraid of losing them."

But Jesus said, "My son, if sinners entice you, do not give in to them. Do not set foot on their paths. A righteous man is careful in friendship, but the way of the wicked leads them astray. Do not join in with those who drink much wine. Do not join in with the rebellious. Don't enter into partnership with unbelievers for what do people of God have to do with people of sin?"

And so, Penda obeyed God's Word and unlocked the door. He introduced his friends to Jesus. Some left, but some even asked Jesus to come and clean their hearts! Penda learnt that "a man of many companions may come to ruin, but there is a friend who sticks closer than a brother." **Proverbs 18:24** 

And then one day Jesus said: "Penda, here is a cupboard which is so dirty. Let's clean it out." Penda got a fright! He did not want Jesus to look in this cupboard. In this cupboard, he kept the hate that he had been storing in his heart for his uncle John. Uncle John had beaten and mistreated Penda as a child. Penda hated him and because of this, he felt angry and troubled. "No!" He cried: "I was so deeply hurt by Uncle John. I won't throw away my hate for him. He deserves my hate."

But Jesus said: "Love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you. Get rid of all rage, bitterness and anger. Be kind and compassionate, forgiving each other, just as God forgave you." Matthew 5:44; Ephesians 4:31-32

Penda listened to Jesus and decided to forgive his uncle and let go of his anger. The peace of God flooded his soul. Again, he could pray: "Forgive me my trespasses as I forgive those who trespass against me." **Matthew 6:12** 

### IF YOUR HEART WERE A HOUSE, WOULD JESUS BE WELCOME IN EVERY ROOM

Jesus says: "Here I am! I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears my voice and opens the door, I will go in and eat with him and he with me." **Revelation 3:20** When you open the door of your heart, Jesus doesn't look in and say: "Oh no! First clean up your house," and go away. He comes in and cleans up all the mess and the dirty corners of sin. **Isaiah 1:18** says that He makes you as white as snow. If your house gets dirty again, Jesus doesn't leave, but He does not feel comfortable there.



It is sin that makes your house dirty. Just as we must sweep and clean our house daily, so you must give your heart a daily sweep and dust: by confessing your sins and asking Jesus to forgive you.

We constantly face the struggle of who is going to be in charge of our lives: God or Self. **CONTINUALLY** allow Him to be in control of all you think, say and do.

#### PENDA'S HEART - CHRIST'S HOME

When Penda heard Jesus knocking at the door of his heart, he opened the door and Jesus came in. He became a new person. Jesus forgave his sins and they had fellowship together, talking and being friends.

But there was one room which Penda kept locked. It was the room where he entertained friends who did not know Jesus.

They influenced Penda to swear, drink and do bad things. Penda felt guilty because he knew that this did not please the Lord. So, he kept the door locked.

**IT IS NOT OKAY TO CHOOSE A NON-CHRISTIAN** as a life partner or to have a special so-called girlfriend/boyfriend relationship with him/her if you are a Christian.

#### **HOW SHOULD I HANDLE MY SEXUAL DESIRE?**

We all have a desire for sex and a desire for true intimacy with one person from the opposite sex, but God has placed a limit on your sexual desire and that limit is leaving your original family (committing to one person for life in a public and legal wedding) and cleaving (practicing the commitment by behaving in a loving and kind way to that person).

Sex is **not** made for love.

## Sex is made for marriage.

And marriage is made for love.

Your body is designed in a way so that sex with your spouse can be a wonderful and very enjoyable experience. This is why here should be absolutely no sexual touching or behaviour that leads to sexual arousal before you are married.

When you are engaged to be married, you can show PHYSICAL affection for each other with hugs, being close, holding hands

and short kisses. But do not be physically *intimate* by kissing and being close in a way that leads to sexual arousal and sex.

#### WHAT IS GOD'S WILL FOR MY LIFE?

Many young people are asking this question and looking for a dream or vision or prophet to tell them the answer. The Good News is that to find out God's will for your life today. You don't need a dream, a vision or a prophet, because God wrote you a letter to tell you what to do!

The only time in the Bible that we read of God actually writing something with his own hand for us is the **TEN COMMANDMENTS**. He also actually spoke them to the people – they heard the voice of the Almighty God! If you do not do these things then you are not doing the will of God.

The first four commandments are about loving God and the last six commandments relate to loving your neighbour.

Examine your life and ask yourself: "Am I doing the will of the Father?"

Love God with all your heart, soul and mind. Love is not just a nice feeling. It means to always please God before you please yourself. You show it by your actions. Here are some things you can do today and you can be sure you are doing His will.

- Worship God only. Nothing should be more important to you than pleasing God and obeying Him.
- Never ever use His Name lightly. This means not to say "My God!" in your normal conversation. His Name is the Name above all Names. Have great respect and honour when His name is on your lips.
- Rest one day out of every 7. When you are resting, remember God and your redemption. Do all your work in six days. Don't be lazy, plan well and save your rest for the Sabbath day.
- **Be honest.** Do not lie. Do not steal. There is never any excuse for lying or stealing. You cannot be a whole person if you steal and lie.
- **Be pure sexually.** If you are not married, you have no sexual rights over anybody.
- **Be content with what you have.** Don't look at what others have and say "It's not fair," or "I must also have what they have," or "What about me?" Be thankful for what you have.
- Honour your father and your mother. Be a good son or daughter to your parents. Respect their authority and do things to show that you honour them.
- Protect the value of all human life. Remember everybody is a person made in the image of God.

#### **SOME PRACTICAL ADVICE**

If you have sinned sexually, there is forgiveness in Christ. Turn from your past ways. From now on be faithful to the person you will marry, even if you have never met.

- Clearly decide to keep yourself for your marriage partner. Do not be half-hearted. Believe the truth and commit yourself to the truth. Don't let anybody weaken your resolve. You are under no obligation to have sex with anybody. Don't allow anyone to misuse you. Respect your body and expect respect from others. YOU ARE WORTH WAITING FOR.
- 2. Discuss your decision with anyone who wants a relationship with you.

  State very clearly that you are not interested in an intimate physical relationship. If he/she does not accept this and tries to change your mind, do not pursue that relationship. This person is more interested in satisfying their desire for a sexual relationship than in you as a person, or they wrongly believe that being boyfriend and girlfriend means you can or must have sex.
- **3. Avoid temptation.** The wrong place, the wrong time, the wrong companions, the wrong internet and social media can quickly dissolve your decision to be pure. Stay away from situations where it is easy to become involved in sex.
- **4. Avoid alcohol and other drugs.** These diminish good judgment and take away your ability to act responsibly.

#### WHAT IF IT IS TOO LATE TO KEEP MYSELF?

It is never too late because God has made a way for you to find forgiveness and start over again.

• Confess the sin and your past and present sexual activity. Confess your lust and impurity. Isaiah 1:18, 1 John 1:9.

Turn away from your sin. Stop having sex immediately and break off your relationship with your present partner. **John 8:1-11.** 

- Resolve to keep sex for and until marriage. Do not have a dating relationship with anybody for at least a year or two. This will give you time to renew your mind through the Word of God. Ask God for grace and strength. He will help you.

- Find a group or person to encourage and help you as you move forward.

#### The manufacturer knows best!

When Mr. Hangala brought a new decoder and playstation home, his children, Festus and Maria were very excited. Now they could record the World Cup Final for their uncle who was in hospital. Festus and Maria decided to set-up recorder and started to fiddle with the

buttons and knobs. Every time they tried to record, all that appeared on the screen were stripes and dots. They started to argue about how to do it.

Mr. Hangala came in and pointed out that they had not consulted the manufacturer's manual which the factory had supplied with the machine. He took the manual and tried to follow the instructions. But the children had damaged the delicate machine.

The next day he had to take it back to the factory where they repaired the damage and showed him how to set it up correctly. It cost a lot of money and the children had to work to pay for it.

#### 1. WE BELONG TO GOD: HE MADE US

The Hangala family could choose whether to obey the manufacturer of the decoder and playstation or not. You can choose to obey God or not to obey Him.

Disobedience carries a severe penalty. Broken machines or a broken useless life. We are just like Festus and Maria. We want to do things our own way and we sometimes end up making a mess of our lives. Then we think if we read the Bible and pray, things will get better.

But they do not. Instead, we must take our broken lives back to the One who know how to fix them.

He paid the penalty for the damage we have done!
